

Iowa Renewable Fuels Infrastructure Program

The Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship (IDALS) offers cost-share grants for the installation of E85 dispensers, blender pumps, biodiesel retail systems, and biodiesel storage facilities.

RETAIL

Grants cover 50% of total expenses or a maximum of \$30,000 with a three-year contract requirement for:

- E85 dispensers or blender pumps
- Biodiesel dispensers or blender pumps

Grants are also available that cover 70% of total expenses or a maximum of \$50,000 with a **five-year** contract requirement for:

- E85 dispensers or blender pumps
- Biodiesel dispensers or blender pumps
 - ➤ Multiple Location Incentive: After the initial installation, by adding additional renewable fuels at multiple locations within a 12-month period a retailer is eligible to receive an additional \$6,000 per location for up to four locations. This program may be repeated annually.

Retailers may receive separate grants for E85 and biodiesel for the same location (separate applications required).

Additional grants are offered that cover up to 75% of the cost to **upgrade** or **replace** existing E85 dispensers to dispensers that are listed as compatible by an independent laboratory within four years following publication of an order to this affect by the State Fire Marshal. *Dresser Wayne and Gilbarco offer E85 dispensers that are certified by Underwriter's Laboratory.*

WHOLESALE

Grants cover 50% of total expenses for biodiesel terminals that:

- Store, blend OR dispense: B2 B98; maximum \$50,000 grant
- Store, blend <u>AND</u> dispense: B99 B100; maximum \$100,000 grant (maximum \$800,000 in cumulative B99/B100 grants, effective January 1, 2009)

Grant applications are subject to Renewable Fuels Infrastructure Board approval and funding availability.

IOWA TAX INCENTIVES

E15 Tax Credit: 15% - 69% (E15 – E69): 3 cents/gallon for tax years 2011 – 2014 70% - 85% (E70 – E85): 16 cents/gallon for tax years 2012 - 2017
